Survey for John Tom (Charles B. Stewart assignee) of 1806. 426 square varas of land, situated on the East margin of the Navasoto River, in Grimes County, about $18\frac{1}{2}$ miles N.W. of the town of Anderson, being a part of the quantity to which he is entitled by virtue of allocated balanced Certificate No. $\frac{1527}{166}$, dated 30th day of May, 1850, for four million. 073, 613 square varas.

Beginning on the West side of Thomas McDonald's survey, at the N.E. Corner of Mortimer Donoho's survey, at a stake from which a post oak, 20 in. dia. marked A bears N. 32° W. $33\frac{1}{2}$ var. dist., and a post oak, 16 in. dia. marked A bears N. $33\frac{1}{2}$ E. $12\frac{1}{2}$ var. dist.

Then South 89° W.

2060 varas to the N.W. Corner of Mortimer Donoho's survey, on the East bank of the Navasoto River at a post from which a post oak, 10 in. dia. marked D, bears S. 29° E. 4 var. dist., and a post oak, 9 in. dia. marked D bears S. 50° W. 4 var. dist.

Then up the East side of Navasoto, as follows:

to a post from which a black gum, 16 in. dia. marked H bears S. 60° E. $2\frac{3}{4}$ var. dist., and an elm, 10 in. dia. marked H. bears S. 58° E. $3\frac{1}{2}$ var. dist.

Thence South 71° E.

1050 varas intersected the West boundary line of Thos. McDonald's survey, at a post from which a post oak, 12 in. dia. marked H, bears N. 43° W. 13 1/2 varas. dist and a post oak, 9 in. dia. marked H, bears N. 9° W. 10 varas distant, and a post oak, 20 in. dia. marked H, bears N. 25° W. 17 varas distant.

Thence South 19° W. with W. line of McDonald. 1400 varas to the beginning. The above survey is all pasture land.
