And the said George W. Mercer is entitled to hold said land and donate the same, and exercise all rights

This Certificate will be transferable by Endorsement, with a Deed, before any competent authority, with witnesses to the same.

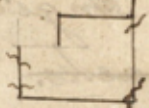

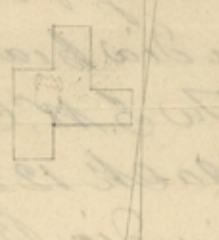
