KNOW ALL MEN TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME,

That Benjamin Puttuff having served faithfully and honorably for the Term of ~~thirty~~ Months, from the ~~thirtyfirst~~ day of October 1836 until the ~~eighteenth~~ day of May 1837 and having been honourably discharged is entitled to Six hundred and Forty (additional) Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And ~~the said~~ Wyatt Hanks, assignee is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same; and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

In Testimony whereof, I have hereunto set my Hand, at Austin this twenty eighth day of November 1840
