That Joseph Bainhart — having served faithfully and honorably for the term of twenty seven — Months from the first day of September 1836 — until the twenty third — day of January 1839 — and having been honorably discharged by proclamation of the President of the United States is entitled to twelve hundred and eighty Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said Joseph Bainhart is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

In Testimony Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand, at the City of Washington

this twenty second day of April — 1839.

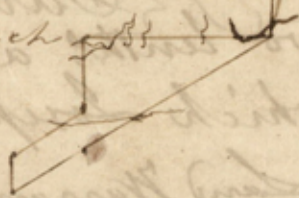
