ed all the duties required of him as a citizen.

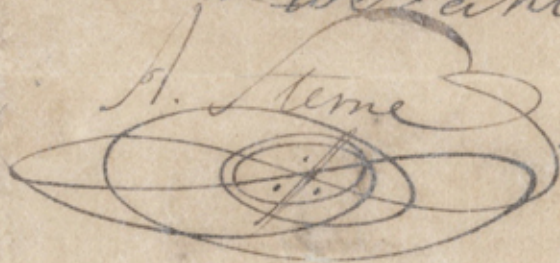
