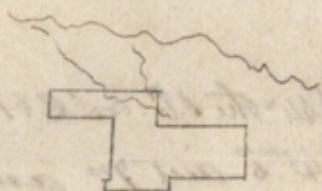

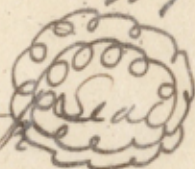

his heirs and assigns forever, my Headright claim
to Twelve Hundred and eighty acres of Land
and the Land Certificate for the same Granted
to me said Stark by the Board of Land Com-
missioners in and for San Augustine County
the Conditional, Cert. dated 6th July A.D. 1838. the
unconditional dated 10th October A.D. 1849 N^o 461-

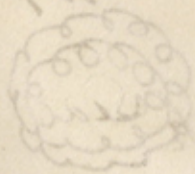
