The State of Texas } To all whom it may concern
Anderson County } Ducting Be it known that
I James G. Beeson have this day nominated con-
-stituted and appointed and by these presents do
nominate constitute and appoint Valentine S
Anglin my true and lawful attorney for his own
name and for his own use to claim and
apply for and receive from the General Land
office of the State of Texas a patent for the
one half of my head right certificate of
Land this day issued to me by the Board
of Land Commissioners of Anderson County
for five hundred and forty acres about
nine days fourth the said one half
being three hundred and twenty acres and
which is located and surveyed in what is
now the county of Cherokee on the waters of
the Neches River and for a more full and
complete description of said Land reference
is hereby made to the field notes of the same
made by Thos J. Hays Deputy Surveyor of
Washington County bearing date the 27
day of June A D 1845 and duly recorded
in the county Surveys office of said county
and the same when receiving the proper Receipts
and vouchers in my name to give and to
do and perform all such other matters and
things that may be necessary to the obtaining
said patent in his Anglin's own name
and for his own use hereby ratifying
and confirming all things he may do
touching the premises in as full ample and
complete a manner as though I were
personally present at the doing thereof
or had done the same in my own
