Honorable discharge

is entitled to Three Hundred and Twenty acres  
Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE

And the said William. F. Williams  
is entitled to hold said Land; or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same; and to  
exercise all rights of ownership over it.

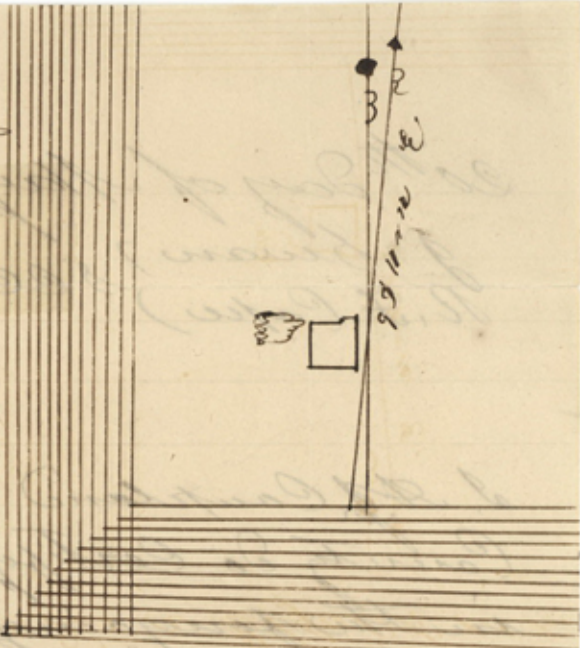
