KNOW ALL MEN TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

THAT Robert Kessler having served faithfully and honorably for the term of Ten months from the 1st day of February 1837 until the 31st day of January 1838 and being honorably discharged from the Army of Texas is entitled to nine hundred and thirty Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his Certificate.

And the said Robert Kessler is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

This Certificate will be transferable by Endorsement, with a Deed, before any competent Authority, with Witnesses to the same.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That in and for the consideration of *Two* *hundred* dollars, cash in hand to me and to my satisfaction paid, which I declare to be full and entire compensation, the receipt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged and confessed; I, *Robert Kinster*, late of the *Army of Texas* — have this day given, granted, donated, alienated, transferred and conveyed, and by these presents do give, grant, donate, alienate, transfer and convey unto *Sydney Gorman & James M. Patton* of the *county and Republic above named*, all my right, title, interest and claim, in and to *nine hundred and fifty* acres bounty land, acquired by *Seven* months services in the Army of Texas as will more fully appear by reference to the Land Certificate, number *fifteen hundred and six*, bearing date at Houston, on the *second* day of *January* in the year eighteen hundred and thirty-eight, drawn in my favor, under the hand of the honorable *Barnard E. Bee, Secy of War*, which certificate is made a part and parcel of this deed, to have and to hold the said land, to *them the said Gorman & Patton* *their* heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to *his* and their own proper use, benefit and behoof forever, with full and ample power to select, locate, get a patent and take possession of the same in *his* or their own name, and use the same as *his* or their own property; alienating and renouncing from this day, from myself, my heirs executors and administrators, to *them the said Gorman & Patton, & their* ~~and his~~ legal representatives, all right, power or control of the same.

And for the further security of the said *Gorman & Patton, their* heirs and successors in the enjoyment of the property hereby to *them* conveyed, I have herewith conveyed, transferred and delivered over and by these presents do convey, transfer and deliver over to *them* and from myself forever alienate, the original certificate herein before described, which I have endorsed in the same manner that I have herein below signed this deed; and I vouch that I am the legal owner of the land certificate having never heretofore sold the same or any part thereof

In testimony of all which I have hereunto set my hand and seal, at Houston, this *11th* day of *January* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-eight, in the presence of *Charles W. Miller* and *J. M. Clinton Harris*, of the county of Harrisburg, witnesses signing with me, and Andrew Briscoe, chief justice of the county, and *ex officio* a Notary Public, who has also hereunto affixed his hand and seal, to give this all the faith and credence of a Notarial act.
