served in the siege of Bexar in December 1835

DONATION LAND,

IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ACT OF CONGRESS, PASSED DEC. 21, 1837.

and also in accordance with an Act passed Feb. 2, 1844

SAID Stephen Jones

His Heirs, Executors, Administrators,

OR THEIR ASSIGNS,

ARE ENTITLED TO HOLD THE SAID LAND:

BUT IT CANNOT BE SOLD, ALIENATED, OR MORTGAGED,

AND IS EXEMPT FROM EXECUTION

DURING THE LIFE-TIME OF THE PERSON TO WHOM IT IS GRANTED.

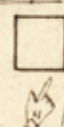
