Term of the District Court for the County  
and Republic aforesaid Jacob  
Crawford filed his petition claim-  
ing a league and labor of land  
by virtue of a certificate for said  
amount of land issued to G. W.  
Hokit assignee of Wesley Dikes  
and further by virtue of his being the  
legal assignee of the said G. W. Hokit  
and that a jury of good and lawe-  
ful <sup>men</sup> being empaneled to try  
the issue submitted to them in  
said petition found a verdict  
in favour of said Jacob Craw-  
ford for a league and labor of  
land - In testimony of which I  
Peter F. Rempfer Clerk of the District  
Court for the County and Republic  
aforesaid issue this certificate  
under my hand and the seal of  
this Court this 23<sup>d</sup> October A.D. 1841.

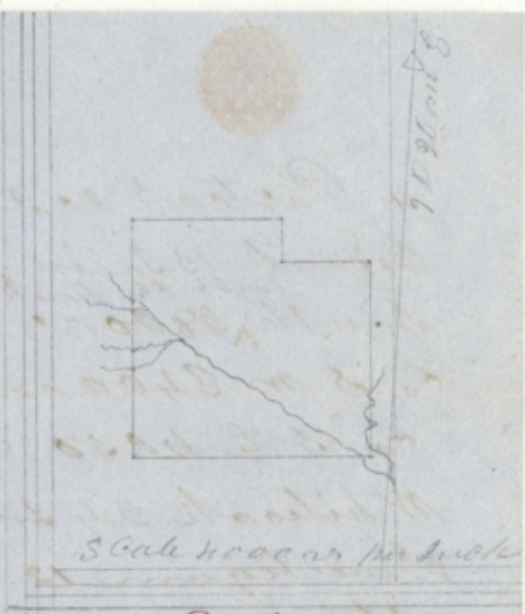
