The Republic of Texas } This is to certify that on the 28th day of
County of Tarrant } December 1853, Thomas B. Garrett filed his petition under oath
in the District Court of said County in accordance with an act, entitled,
"An Act Supplementary to an act to detect fraudulent
Land Certificates and to provide for issuing patents to
legal claimants." approved February 11th 1851.

And the said Thomas B. Garrett alleged in his
said petition that he emigrated to this Republic at one thousand
eight hundred and thirty five, and was a resident citizen of Texas
on the day of the declaration of independence, and that he had
received only one league of land, and that he conceived, him-
self entitled to the additional quantity of One Labor of land.

And afterwards, to wit: on the 13th day of May 1854
at the Spring Term of our said District Court for said County, the said
petition came on to be heard, the Republic, having then and there
represented by O. M. Roberts Esq. District Attorney for the fifth Ju-
dicial District, assisted by Samuel H. Wade Esq. an attorney of
said Court, in accordance with said Statute; and a Jury of good and

lawful men being then and there duly empanelled and sworn, ad-
judged the following verdict, to wit: "That the jury find for the plaintiff
Thos. B. Garrett one Labor of Land, Dabst. Dubst. forum."

Upon which verdict the Court rendered the following
Judgment, viz: "Therefore it is ordered and adjudged by the Court
that said plaintiff recover from said Republic and that a certificate
do issue to him the said Thomas B. Garrett, for one Labor of
Land and that he pay all costs of this proceeding to be taxed.
