Dear Sir

I now regard to the J F Blane 9 1/2 acre scrip Survey. You say that the E. B line of the M Garcia is 1266 5/8 or long. and that the S N Johnson Survey runs up 755 or on it and that the distance, from Johnson up to the Pineda is 511 or instead of 305 or as I hope it is to the record that is correct But you will see that the corrected, M Garcia as made by J P Gibson Co Survey of Cherokee, was not made upon the ground as it calls for States on the Pineda, You will see that the W. B line of M Gutierrez No 880 is 1327 or long and that the S N Johnson. runs up 990 or on it. the distance from Johnson up to the Pineda is 337 or. So you will see by the records. that the E. B line of J F Blane Survey would be 337 or and the W. B line would be 511 or a difference of 174 or. So before I went up. the ground. I knew how the Records are shown and I was careful to locate the lines &

course. I found them on the ground as given  
in said black file, and I think you have  
a map showing the distance of each survey  
with the black file note

I of said Guinn County Surveyor of Cherokee  
do certify, that the distance from the N.B  
line of J. N. Jones to the S.B line of J. P. Jones  
Grant is 305 or upon the ground and that  
the distance of 305 or on the J. F. black survey  
is correct upon the ground
