at Youngs Bay in this Republic in January 1840 has resided in
the same the term of three years prior to January 1. 1845.
And has done and performed all the duties required of
him as a Citizen. He is therefore entitled to an Uncondi-
tional grant of three hundred and twenty acres of Land
Under the provisions of an Act of Congress Approved Jan 15. 1841.
