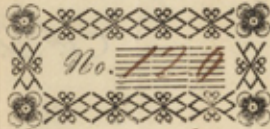

Survey for Wm. Hullerton of one labor of land situated ^{in Brazos Co. on the eastern} on the waters of Little Brazos river ^{above} & near the San Antonio road; it being the complement of one league & labor of land to which he is entitled by virtue of land certificate No. 120. issued by the board of Land Commissioners for Robertson County the 1st March 1838.

Beginning at Henry Hutterton's east corner on Wm. Henry's line at an Elm from which a Post oak bears S. 63. W. 4 1/2. N. - & a Post oak bears N. 53. E. 11. N.

Thence S. 30. E. 250. N. along S. Henry's S.W. line to his south corner stake from which a Post oak 15 in. D. bears N. 64. W. 2. N. - & a Post oak 12 in. D. bears N. 5. W. 5. N.

Thence N. 60. E. 266. N. along S. Henry's S.E. line to a stake from which a Post oak 18 in. D. bears S. 22. W. 3. N. - & a Post oak 15 in. D. bears S. 64. E. 8. N.

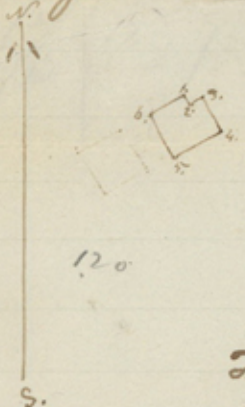
Thence S. 30. E. 750. N. to a stake from which a Post oak 18 in. D. bears S. 1. E. 2. N. - & a Post oak 20 in. D. bears N. 55. W. 7. N.

Thence S. 60. W. 1066. N. to a stake on Robt. Henry's ^{N.E.} line, from which a Post oak 20 in. D. bears N. 2. W. 5. N. - & a Post oak 14 in. D. bears S. 40. E. 6. N.

Thence N. 30. W. 1000. N. along S. Henry's line to his North corner stake on said Hullerton's S.E. line from which a Black Jack 13 in. D. bears N. 67. W. 7. N. - & a Post oak 10 in. D. bears S. 70. E. 5. N. Marked H.H.

Thence N. 60. E. 800. N. along said Hullerton's line to the beginning; marked W.H. Pasture Land.
