was a resident citizen of Texas at the date of

the Declaration of Independence, and that he has continued to be so to this day, and that he was a

married

man at that time and the head of a family; the said

James Thomas

emigrated to Texas in the

year 1834 which entitles him to receive one

*labor of land having
acced a little to a league*

in said Republic.


