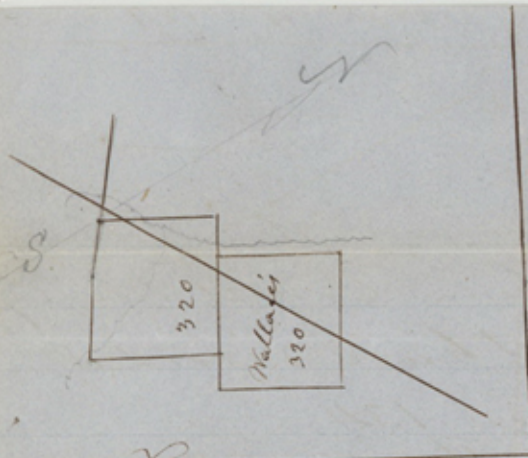



and forty Acres of Land, at the city of Houston
on the 31st day of July A.D. 1838, by George W. Haskely
Secretary of War of the late Republic of Texas
and numbered "486", and that said application
