



Further, the former Mr. A. says that he knows, not from seeing the Certificate, but from hearing the matter spoken of at the time and frequently since, that the said Geo. J. Ashabrammer was entitled to and did receive a Land Certificate from the Shelby County Board of Land Commissioners in or about the year 1838 P. A. D. The latter, A.
