

Know all men by these presents that I Marcellina De La Garza for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars to me in hand paid the full and entire receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, released and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, release and convey unto John A. Green all my right, title and interest in and to Bounty Land Warrant No. 9076 for three hundred and twenty acres of land granted to me on account of Military Service rendered at the storming of Bexar in the year 1835 and issued on the 17th day of September A.D. 1855. Together with all and singular the rights, members, tenements and appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold, all and singular the said Bounty Land Warrant and appurtenances unto him the said John A. Green his heirs and assigns forever. And I hereby bind myself and legal representatives to warrant and defend the same unto him the said John A. Green his heirs and assigns forever.
