That Stephen Gester, having served faithfully and honorably for the term of 14 Months from the 29th day of June 1830 until the twenty ninth day of December 1830 and having been honorably discharged is entitled to six hundred & forty Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said Stephen Gester or his Assignee L. C. [Name] is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

In Testimony Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand, at Austin this 29th day of December 1838 Approved May 9th 1838 James H. Hilliard Adjutant A. S. [Name] SECRETARY OF WAR.

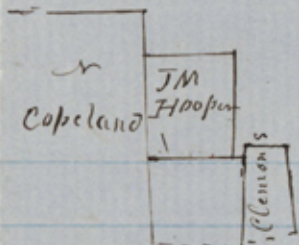

I have surveyed 564 1/2 acres of Land situated in Tarrant County on the waters of the Star River about 5 miles East of the same. ^{and 20 1/2 miles S 73 1/2 W from City of Dallas} By virtue of Stephen Lester's Bounty Land Claim for Six thousand & forty (640) acres of Land No. 6038 issued at Houston on the 29th day of December 1838, by Sidney Johnston Secretary of war approved March the 9th 1853 by James G. Gillett Capt General Registered & approved February the 21st 1859 by Edward Clark Commissioner of Claims.

Beginning at N. Copeland's South E. Corner a little from a Stake br. South 70^o another Stake br. N 80^o W 40^o.

Thence with the San Antonio Road N 82^o E 720^o or. ~~150~~ N 82^o E 230^o or. N 68^o E 320^o or N 55^o E 630 N 60^o E 182 a Stake for corner from which a Stake br. N 29^o W 50^o & a Stake br. S 48^o W 70^o.

Thence N 34^o W 1800^o or to stake from which a Stake 14 in dia br. N 66^o E 20^o or another Stake 13 in dia br. N 50^o W 10^o.

Thence S 56^o W 1900^o or to a stake from which a Stake 12 in dia br. N 27^o E 10^o or also a Stake 18 in dia br. S 82^o E 12^o or.

Thence S 33^o E 1268^o or to the place of Beginning.

Know all men by these presents that I Gardner C. Stanley of the City of Houston for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me paid by Peter W. Eray — also of said City, have bargained, sold, released and conveyed and do by these presents bargain, sell, release and convey unto the said Peter W. Eray his heirs and assigns a certain Bounty Land Certificate number — six thousand and thirty eight (No. 6038) for six hundred and forty acres of land, issued to me as a signee of Stephen Lester as a Soldier honorably discharged and as his Bounty land for services, on the 29th day of December A. D. 1838, by A. Sidney Johnston Secretary of War.

And I hereby sell the said Bounty Certificate to the said Peter W. Eray his heirs and assigns to have & hold the same to their own use forever: and I hereby authorize them to exercise the same rights of ownership of it that I might or could do, to locate, have surveyed and draw the patent from the Government in my own or his or their name or names as I might do were I personally present.
