Before the undersigned authority this day came G. W. Chapman and S. H. Chapman, who severally depose that on, to-wit: the 16th day of December, 1862, one Robert Gillaster (Whose real name was Robert Gillespie) applied to W. W. McGinnis, who was then surveyor of Tarrant County, Texas, to survey for him under the act of 1860, a tract of land about 7 miles south of Port Worth, in Tarrant County, Texas, the corrected field notes of which are hereto attached and made a part of this affidavit. That the said R. Gillaster took possession of said survey and incorporated the same in his home and used and occupied the same adverse^{ly} and continuously for three years and more, to-wit: from the said 16th day of December, 1862 until the 25th day of January, 1866, when he, for a valuable consideration to him then paid, conveyed the same to G. W. Chapman, who was the father of these affiants, and delivered possession thereof to the said J. W. Chapman, and that he and his heirs, and assigns have held continuous adverse possession of the same, using and enjoying the same, and paying taxes thereon from the said 25th day of January, 1866 to the present time, and that this affidavit is made for the purpose of securing the issuance of a patent in favor of the


