P. Farmer one half of my Colony Head Right Certificate No 242 Vol. 1, issued to me on the 5th day of May 1850, by Thomas Wm. Ward Commissioner for Peter's Colony, D. Certificate calls for 640 acres of land, and I, the D. Rogers do hereby authorize and fully empower the Commissioners of the Genl. Land Office of the State aforesaid to issue a patent to or for the land upon which the D. half of D. Certificate may be located and surveyed, to the D. Farmer or to his heirs or assigns. 
