Please have surveyed for me by virtue of an act "to provide for the sale of a portion of the unappropriated public domain lands of the State of Texas and the investment of the proceeds of such sale, approved July 14. A.D. 1879 the following part of the vacant public domain, situated in Brazos County between the Navasoto river and the V. D. Holcomb survey. Beginning at a stake set in San Antonio road near crossing Navasoto river for N. E. corner of a sec. in the name of V. D. Holcomb, from which a Spanish Oak 24 in dia brs N 45 W 34<sup>o</sup> another same size brs S. 45. W 8<sup>o</sup>. Thence S. 45 E with E. line of said Holcomb survey to the W. bank of Navasoto river. Thence up said river with its meanders to the place of beginning including all the vacant land.
