Slaughter three hundred and twenty acres  
of Land which I hold by right of Premp-  
tion and which was surveyed by A. J.  
Lee on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. 1853. on  
the waters of Sycamore Creek, and lying  
west of three hundred and twenty acres  
sold this day by said Sublett to the  
said Slaughter, and being the place  
on which said Sublett now lives, and  
the said Sublett hereby transfers all  
his right title and interest in and  
to said Preemption unto the said Slaughter  
his heirs or assigns forever, and he further  
agrees to give Possession of the same  
to the said Slaughter by the first day  
of November next.
