was introduced into Texas by virtue of the Colonization Contract of H. F. Fisher and Burchard Moeller, with the President of the late Republic of Texas, before the 1st day of September, A. D. 1847, and that said

George L. Hebgun has not yet received a CERTIFICATE for his

Land, and having proved the facts above stated by two disinterested, respectable witnesses, and the said

George L. Hebgun

having in like manner proved that he was a head of a family at the time of his said introduction

he is entitled to Six hundred forty acres of land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE:

And as the surveys made by the German Emigration Company have been exhausted, the said

George L. Hebgun is entitled to a CERTIFICATE on any unappropriated

territory within the limits of the said Colony, as provided for by an Act of the Legislature of the State of Texas, approved December 2, 1850.

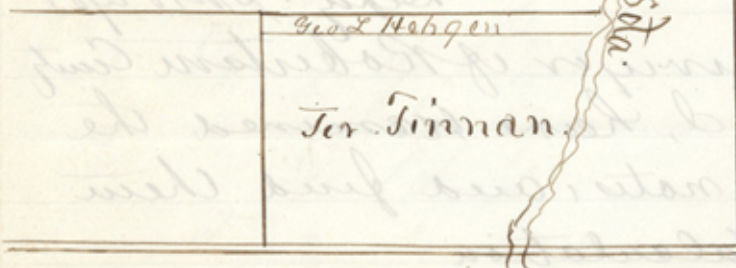

River about 15 miles S 70° E of Owensville
Beginning at a stake the North East Corner of the Ter. Finnan League, thence with said League S 58 W 6700 varas to stake on East Line of a Survey made in name of Lavinia Robitson for the South West Corner of this survey, thence N 32 West 265 varas to its N E Corner a stake set on the South Line of Jose Ma. Viesca 11 League grant for the N W Corner of this survey, thence with said 11 league line N 58 E 6700 varas to a stake on bank of the Narasota River for the N E Corner of this survey, thence with the Narasota River S 32 E 265 varas to the beginning containing 314 acres of Land.
