The legal heirs of Richard Morris deceased are entitled to three hundred and twenty acres of land by virtue of the annexed Conditional Certificate No 520 for 320 acres of land. 2^d class issued to the said Richard Morris by the Board of Land Commissioners of Harrisburg County on 22^d September 1839.

It having been proven to the County Court of Galveston County that the said Morris resided permanently in Texas from the time of the issuance of said Conditional Certificate to the date of ^{his} death and performed all the duty of a good citizen his death in 1844, and it also having been proven to the satisfaction of the Court that the publication by statute in such case made & provided has been made in the "News", a newspaper published and printed in Galveston County. Wherefore there an unconditional Certificate for three hundred and twenty acres of land is issued to the legal heirs of said Richard Morris deceased.
