Your application to the County Surveyor of Bosque County, covering a survey of a tract of land, under the act of 1900, together with the field notes rendered in accordance therewith, calling for survey No. 5, blk. No. 48.3 acres, have been received, examined and approved.

The land has been classified as Grazing and valued at \$ 1.00 per acre, and being isolated and detached must be sold as such. (See Sections 5 and 6 of the Act approved February 23rd, 1900, and amended April 15th, 1901.)

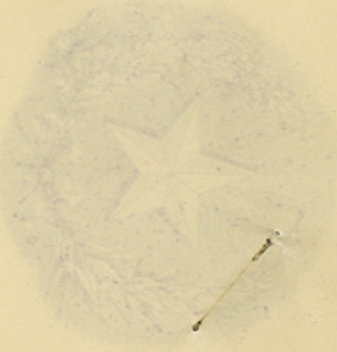
