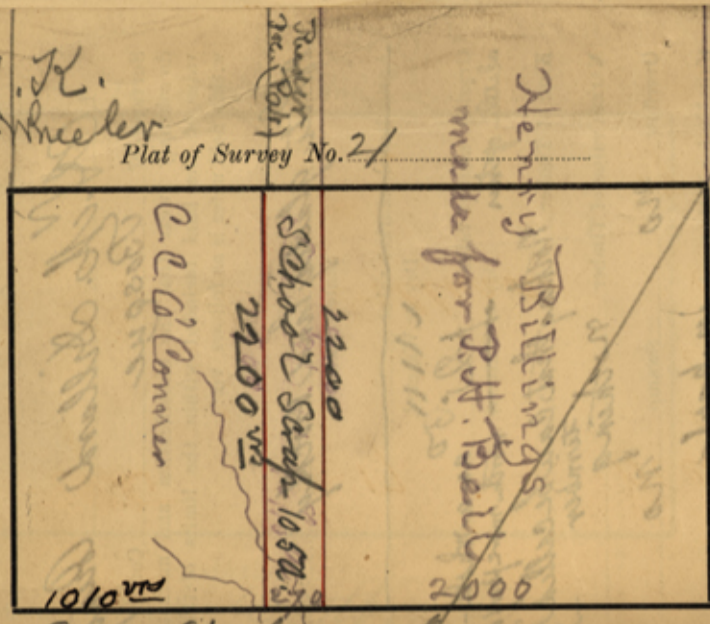

We acknowledge receipt of your favor of the 6th instant, enclosing money order for \$2.00, which balances your account. Now, with reference to the T.I. Lambeth Scrap file No. 8499, survey No. 24, between Henry Billings and C.C. O'Connor, near the North line in Bosque county, beg to advise that same was rejected because according to copy of decree of court, Cause No. 2051, P. T. Yocham vs McCurdy and Davies, District Court Bosque county, also 67th S.W. Rep., page 316, held that there was no vacancy, and upon examining the papers nothing is disclosed indicating that there was a compromise as the case was tried by a jury and a verdict rendered by said jury and that it appearing in accordance with the law this department could not recognize a vacancy under T.I. Lambeths file. If, however, you can establish the fact that the judgment was a compromise and you will furnish this department with these facts the matter will be taken up and carefully investigated. Awaiting your reply and hoping you may furnish the facts or information as will substantially confirm your contention, in this matter. Lambert Report, No. 8499, survey No. 24, between Henry Willard and W. O. O'Connell, near the north line in Borden County, please advise that name was rejected because according to copy of books of court, Cause No. 2051, P. T. Yocham vs. McQuay and Davis, District Court Borden County, also with E.W. Rep., page 210, held that there was no survey, and upon examining the papers showing in abstract including that there was a compromise as to the line of a quarter section, returned by said T.I. Lambert, and that it appeared to be a survey and that the same could not be returned as a survey until T.I. Lambert's survey, No. 8499, was returned. The fact that the same was a compromise and was not returned to this department until after the survey was taken up and eventually returned. Again, your reply and holding you may furnish the facts of the survey as it substantially confirm your contention, in this matter, in writing about this matter heretofore, in this matter, T.I. Lambert's Report, also S.F. No. 8500, in the name of T. I. Lambert.
