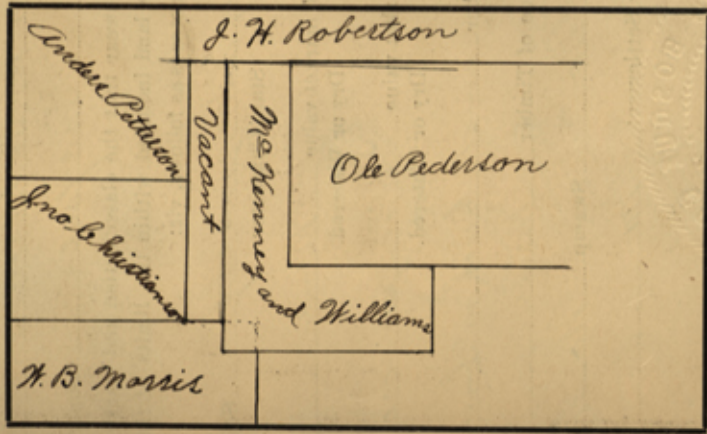


Plat of Survey No. 26
