Field notes of a survey of 640 acres of land made for F. P. Barr. Variation 8° 30' east, by virtue of his affidavit and application made before J. L. Durham on the seventh day of May, 1910, and filed with the Surveyor of Harris County on the twenty-first day of May, 1910, under Section 8 of an Act approved April 15, 1905, providing for the sale of unsurveyed school land appropriated to the Public Free School Fund by an Act approved February 23, 1900. Said land is situated in Harris County about 16 miles north-east from County site, and known as survey No. 4, in Block No. F. P. B. beginning at south-west corner survey No. 3, F. P. B. on the east line of the Whitney Britton survey. a stake.

Thence east along the south line of survey No. 3, 2031.4 varas to the south-east corner of the same on the west line of survey No. 9, F.P.B.

Thence south 78 varas, thence east 227 varas along the south line of survey No. 9, F.P.B.

Thence south 1530.9 varas to the north line of the James Mellin survey.

Thence west along the north line of the James Mellin survey 2258.4 varas to the east line of the J. E. Bundick survey.

Thence north along the east line of the J. E. Bundick and Whitney Britton surveys at 25 varas, the north-east corner of J. E. Bundick and south-east corner Whitney Britton surveys, from which Whitneys trees are marked "B" and the same is 60 varas north of Greens Bayou, continue north, in all 1608.9 varas to the place of beginning.
