Field notes of a survey of 640 acres of land made for F. P. Barr. Variation 8° 30' east, by virtue of his affidavit and application made before J. L. Durham on the Seventh day of May, 1910, and filed with the Surveyor of Harris County on the twenty-first day of May, 1910, under Section 8, of an Act approved April, 15, 1905, providing for the sale of the unsurveyed school land appropriated to the Public Free School Fund by an Act approved February 23, 1900. Said land is situated in Harris County, about 16 miles north-east from County site and known as survey No. 28 in Block No. F. P. B. beginning at the north-east corner of survey No. 27, F. P. B. on the south line of survey No. 26, F. P. B.

Thence east along the south line of survey No. 26, F. P. B. 1697.7 varas to its south-east corner, a stake on the west bank of the San Jacinto River.

Thence south 21° 12' east 500.9 varas, thence south 447.9 varas thence south 22° 24' east 1004.8 varas, a stake on the west bank of the San Jacinto River, the south-east corner of this survey.

Thence west 2270.6 varas a stake on the east line of survey No. 29, thence north along the east line of survey No. 29 and 27, F. P. B. at 185.7 varas the north-east corner of survey No. 29 and the south-east corner survey No. 27, in all 1843.9 varas to the place of beginning.
