



Dear Sir:-

I beg to submit the following report and sketch in connection with the field notes for the two tracts of undivided land surveyed for White Oak, W.F. White, and situated about five miles N. 82 E. from the Courthouse, in Tarrant County, Texas.

I found the southwest corner of the W. R. Reeder survey, the original Burr Oak, bearing S. 87-1/2 E. 9-1/2 vars, being in perfect condition. The land lying in the River valley to the west and southwest and northwest has all been put in cultivation, and all other bearing trees in that section are gone. The northeast corner of the J. I. Purvis I located from its original bearing tree, a Post oak, bearing S. 50 W. 6 vars, some twenty years ago, when the tree was undisturbed. The J. Blackwell has none of its bearing trees remaining; I have relocated its lines from work done by me some 20 years ago, when its landmarks were available.

The sketch shows the actual dimensions measured between the northeast corner of the J. I. Purvis and the southwest corner of the W. R. Reeder, and the relative position of the Blackwell. I have located the J. W. Haynes survey by course and distance from the east corners of the Blackwell; and, all its bearing trees being gone, I have located the W. J. Tandy from its call for the Edwards. I have located the J. Brockman by course and distance from the southwest corner of the Reeder, and similarly, the G. E. P. I. & M. Co. from its call for the west corners of the Tandy.

The above locations disclose two small tracts as vacancies, for which I have returned field notes herewith.


