

I wish to state that at the BEGINNING corner, which is the N W corner of the JF S tephens Survey, I found the Stephens Patent tree, still standing, just as described in my field notes. Also a fence extends East from this corner and the survey line, being the Stephens North line, is plainly marked on timber, the fence being on the line. The East line of this Earl Jones survey, being W B line of Z M Monk survey, was plainly marked in both the North and South directions from the N E corner of said stephens Survey, and at the N W corner of said Monk Sur. I found two old witness trees marked just as shown in my field notes, this corner being in S B line of David Cherry League. The Sbuth Boundary line of saidCherry League is plainly marked and fenced on Eastward from N W corner of said Monk Survey.
