This is to Certify that Eli Nickson
has appeared before us the Board of
Land Commrs for the County of
Fort Bend and proved according
to Law that he arrived in this Republic
when a child ~~and~~ in July 1836 and
was ~~over~~ ^{then} ~~the~~ ^{less} than ten years of age at
the date of his Independence and
a single man and entitled to one third
of a League of land upon the condition
of paying at the rate of two dollars
& forty Cents for each labor of pasture
land and five dollars for each labor
of arable land which may be
contained in the survey made to
him by this Certificate given
under our hands this 11th day of
January
1838.

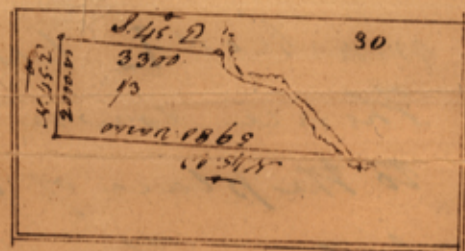

Navesota being the quantity of land to which he
is entitled by virtue of a Certificate N^o. 16. issued
by the board of Land Commissioners for the County
of Fort-bend. Beginning at the upper corner
of a tract of land of 15 1/2 Labors surveyed for
Thomas Bowman. which corner stands on the
west bank of the Navesota a stake from which
a pin oak marked W bears N. 20. E. 10. Varas
distant and an Elm marked I. bears North 5. W.
14 varas distant. Thence S. 45. W. with the N. E. bound-
line of said Bowmans tract 5980. varas to his N. E.
corner in the S. E. boundary line of a League of land
in the name of J. D. Allcorn Adm. of the Estate of
J. W. Stewart, a stake from which a Black Jack
marked X. bears S. 64. W. 2. varas distant and a
Black Jack marked B. bears N. 40. E. 13. varas dis-
-tant. Thence N. 45. E. 2000. varas to the East corner
said Allcorns League. Thence S. 45. E. at 1220. varas
a creek 5. varas wide, runs S. E. at 3300 varas the
Navesota where set a stake for the ~~lower~~
upper corner from which a pin oak marked
E bears S. 20 1/2. E. 4. varas distant, and a pin oak

marked L. bears S 83. W. 9. Varas distant.

Thence down the Navasota with the meanders thereof
to the place of beginning. The above Survey
contains Three Labors of arable land and Five and
a Third Labors of pasture land.
