TEXAS AND PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY,

Having completed a section of 11½ miles and 375 feet of the Transcontinental branch of said railway, viz: From a point 1500 feet west of the Honey Grove depot to the junction with the main line of said Texas and Pacific Railroad; and a section of 35 miles and 2903 feet of the main line of said Texas and Pacific Railroad, viz: From Dallas to Fort Worth, making a total measurement of main track, single line, 139 miles and 1543 feet, and of switches and turnouts 8 miles and 1735 feet, is entitled under the provisions of its charter and the General Laws governing the same, to **SIX HUNDRED AND FORTY ACRES OF LAND**, which may, by virtue of this Certificate, be located upon the odd sections within said Railway Company's Reservation, and to be surveyed in the following manner:

First. Two sections of land adjoining and connecting with each other shall be surveyed, one for the State and the other for the company.

Second. The surveys to be made square, unless prevented by previous entries or navigable streams.

Third. The Commissioner will select and number the surveys and report the result to the Surveyor, who will fill up the blanks left in his record for that purpose, accordingly. (As a matter of convenience in describing the surveys, when reporting the numbers the Surveyor should number the field notes temporarily, in pencil.)

Fourth. Portions of land of less size than 1280 acres of land, surrounded by previous surveys must be equally divided, one-half surveyed for the State and the other half for the Company, and the residue of the Certificate may in like manner be located elsewhere, until the same is exhausted.

Fifth. The even numbers will be reserved to the State, and the odd numbers to the company.
