Information having been received, as required by this Act that said Company have completed the *12<sup>th</sup>* Section of *Five* miles, making in all, *60* miles from *Harrisburg* of their Road in accordance with the provisions of their Charter and *the above cited act*.

Johnson Compt<sup>r</sup> of the State of Texas, in accordance with "An Act to amend the Act to incorporate the Buffalo Bayou, Brazos and Colorado Railway Company," approved January 29<sup>th</sup>, 1853, to wit: Certificate No. 305 being one of the FORTY Certificates to which said Company are entitled for constructing the five miles of their Road, next following the Fifty fifth mile of the same.

Witness, the hand of their President and their Corporate Seal, by virtue of the "Act to authorize the B. B., B. & C. Railway Company to assign Land Certificates," approved February 9<sup>th</sup>, 1854, and the By-Laws of said Company, this 19<sup>th</sup> day of October A. D. 1859.

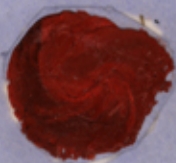
