

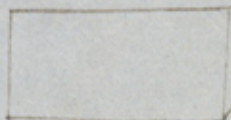

/ Personally appeared before the undersigned authority

on this day L.H. Scrutchfield, who after being by me duly sworn on his oath says, that he is now 71 years of age, and is a County Commissioner of Bosque County, Texas,. That he is and for many years has been a practical Surveyor, and personally located many of the Surveys in Bosque County. At one time was County Surveyor of Bosque County. That ~~that~~ at the time the Joseph Harlan Survey in Bosque County was originally located, Affiant lived on the John C. Pool Survey, adjoining the Harlan Survey. That the original Surveying party of the Harlan Survey, dined with this Affiant on the day the Harlan Survey was surveyed, and within 1/4th, of a mile of the S.W. Corner thereof. That said surveyors pointed out and described to this Affiant the South line of said Harlan Survey, and that this Affiant went over said line and personally examined it, the next day, and saw the original corners, consisting of piles of rock made for the S.W. and S.E. Corner thereof.

That Affiant was the County Surveyor of Bosque County, at the time when the Wash Lock Survey and the J.E. Tabor Survey were located South of and adjoining the Harlan Survey, and that ~~they~~ Affiant located and actually surveyed said Lock and Tabor Surveys. That he located the North lines of said Surveys on the South line of the Harlan Survey, and wrote the field notes calling for said Harlan Survey. That the North line of said Locke and Tabor Surveys were established and located on the same line shown to this Affiant by the original Surveying party aforesaid as the South line of the Harlan Survey, and as traced and seen by this Affiant on the next day after the location of said Harlan Survey. That Affiant so located said Wash Locke and Tabor Surveys, because he designed and intended to make them close on to the South line of the Harlan Survey as he

personally knew it to exist on the ground at the time. That the South line of said Harlan Survey ran through timber on its Western end, and was plainly marked on the timber. That the marked line was found and seen by Affiant when he located the Locke and Tabor Surveys.

That the Affiant has lived within two miles of said Harlan Survey from the day it was located until now, and he personally is well acquainted with the County, and knows that the North line of the Locke and Tabors Surveys were located on the line actually run by the original Surveying party, as the South line of the Harlan, Survey:
