Rail Road Company to SIX HUNDRED AND FORTY ACRES OF LAND, to be Located upon any of the Vacant and Unappropriated Public Domain of the State of Texas, in accordance with the provisions of "An Act to Encourage the Construction of Rail Roads in Texas, by donations of Lands," approved January 30th, 1854, and an Order of the Governor of the State of Texas, dated January 30th, 1854, Information having been received, as required by said act, that said Company have completed a section of Twenty five miles of its Road in accordance with the provisions of its charter and the general laws regulating Rail Roads.

The Lands granted to said Company are to be located in alternate sections and surveyed in the following manner:

1st. For each certificate granted the Company a like number of acres to be surveyed for the use of the State.

2d. To be surveyed in square blocks of not less than six miles, unless prevented by previous surveys, or navigable streams.

3d. The Surveys to be delineated upon a map or maps, with the even and odd sections differently colored; and regularly numbered from one upwards, to the full number contained in the block.

4th. The field notes of said Surveys, with the map or maps, to be deposited in the General Land Office, and all the alternate or even sections, shall be reserved to the use of the State, and the odd sections to become the property of the Company.




