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The State of Texas, Before me the undersigned
County of Baskin District Clerk in and for
the county aforesaid this day came and per-
sonally appeared E. H. Barcroft a resident
citizen of said county who being by me duly
sworn declares that he is a bona fide settler
upon one Hundred and sixty acres of vacant
public land situated in said county and
surveyed for E. H. Barcroft on the 4th day
of March 1868 by Ward Keeler
Surveyor of said county that he has
occupied and improved the same as
a homestead for the period of three
consecutive years beginning on the 3rd day
of March 1868 that he is a married
man and that he makes this affidavit for
the purpose of obtaining a title to the
same for a homestead under an act
supplementary to an act to regulate the
disposal of the Public Lands of the State
of Texas approved March 24th 1871
and that he has not a homestead other
than the above, And also at the same
time came and personally appeared
E. L. Detherage and L. O. Barcroft two
credible resident citizens of said county
to me known who being duly sworn depo-
ses and say that E. H. Barcroft the person
first above named in this affidavit, has

actually settled upon and cultivated as a homestead
the land surveyed for him on the 15 day of
January 1868 by the surveyor aforesaid for
the period of three years and they nor either
of them have any interest in the said land

Survey is situated ^{in Bosque County} on the Waters of the Bosque. and on the
South Side thereof about $11\frac{1}{2}$ miles $N 81^{\circ} W$ of Meridian

Beginning at the S.E. Corner of a Survey in the
Name of Calvin Stockbridge for 1280 acres a Pile of Rocks
Thence S. $30^{\circ} E$. 787 Varas to the N.E. Corner of a Survey in

the Name of C. L. Deathridge from which a Live Oak
marked V is N. $25^{\circ} E$ 200. Varas & another marked X. is
N. $29^{\circ} E$ 220 Varas

Thence S. $60^{\circ} W$. 9150. Varas. to a Pile of Rocks in Prairie

Thence N. $30^{\circ} W$ 787 Varas. to a Corner in the South line of
Calvin Stockbridge's Survey a Pile of Rocks.

Thence N. $60^{\circ} E$ with the South line of Stockbridge Survey
1150 Varas to the beginning
