 acres of land made for W. K. King it being
 the land to which he is entitled by
 virtue of compliance with an act
 of the Legislature passed August
 26th A.D. 1857 to authorize the Location
 and settlement of the Mex. and
 Pacific Rail Road Reserve as
 appears by the attached Affidavits
 marked No 14. ^{in Bosque County} situation on
 the west side of the Brazos River
 below the mouth of Ceanon creek,
^{about 14 miles S. 86° E from Meridian}
Beginning at the S. E. corner
 of a survey made for S. J. King for
 the S. E. corner of this survey from
 which a Post Oak marked A
 bears S. 18° E. 50 varas and another marked
 X bears S. 30° E. 30 varas thence up the
 River with its meanders N. 55° W.
238 varas to the S. E. corner which
 is also the S. E. corner of a survey
 in the name of Gertrudes Chirino
 from which a Pecan marked I
 bears N. 64° E. 70 varas and a Spanish
 oak marked II bears N. 9° E. 20 varas
thence S. 60° W. 958 varas to the N. W.
 corner a mound thence S. 50° E. 212
 varas to the S. W. corner a mound
thence N. 60° E. 1071 varas to the beginning
