THIS CERTIFICATE entitles the

**Gulf, Colorado and Santa Fe Railway Company**

To Six Hundred and Forty Acres of Land, to be located upon any of the vacant and unappropriated public domain of the State of Texas, in accordance with the provisions of an act entitled "An act to Encourage the Construction of Railroads in Texas by donations of Land," approved January 30, 1854, and acts amendatory thereof; and in accordance with the provisions of "An act to incorporate The Gulf, Colorado and Santa Fe Railway Company, and to grant land in aid of the construction of the same," passed May 28, 1873, information having been received as required by said acts, that said Company has completed a section of Fifty-One Miles and 2960 feet of their road.

The lands granted to said Company are to be located in alternate sections, and surveyed in the following manner:

*First. Two sections of land adjoining and connecting with each other must be surveyed, one for the State and the other for the Company*

*Second. The surveys to be made square, unless prevented by precious entries or navigable streams.*

*Third. The Commissioner will select and number the surveys and report the result to the Surveyor, who will fill up the blank left in his record for that purpose, accordingly. (As a matter of convenience in describing the surveys, when reporting the number the Surveyor should number the field notes temporarily, in pencil.)*

*Fourth. In dividing the surveys a fraction of over three hundred and twenty acres will be counted as a whole section, and two fractions of less than three hundred and twenty acres will be regarded as a section.*

*Fifth. The even numbers will be reserved to the State, and the odd numbers to the Company.*

me a letter from you of the  
6 inst. in regard to the  
L & S F R R Co Survey by virtue  
No 2377. Acq. - S 1254.

You say that the Survey conflict  
with the Brooks Williams &  
P. E. Beaw. League. - I can not  
see wherein that the Survey can  
conflict with the Beaw. League  
for No 1 Begins at the S W Cor  
of said League. and runs  
with the S W line & No 2 Begins  
at the N. W. Cor. of Brooks  
Williams League on the S W  
line of said Beaw. League  
Now the Law is plain as to  
where the Map show a conflict  
and there is none on the ground  
see P. D. Page 561 & Art 3420  
I have sent you a plot and  
a certificate. Setting forth that  
no conflict exist on the ground

and you will see that the  
Survey that made the Survey for  
D Luce. made about the same  
call. from the S W cor. of P E  
Brew to the S W cor. of Brooke  
Williams. The course that I  
know that I am correct. I  
have Mr Forman that now  
owns the P E Brew all along  
the S W line and his Father  
has owned. See 1846 and  
Mr Chapman that owns  
the Brooke Williams adjoining  
the same and I know I am  
correct. - The only thing that  
can be the matter the records  
may show the distance from  
the S W cor. of B Williams  
to the S W cor. of Brew not  
to be so great as called  
for and that will bring  
it down to this that No 1 &  
No 2. conflict which is not  
the case

Now if you will not please  
write to me or Mr Tempton  
how it conflicts. who will  
say that you do not care for  
the certificate of the Survey

and what you wish done  
and I will make the Sur.  
and send up to you stating  
in the Certificate that the  
Sur was made according  
to your instructions, with out  
any regard to the Governor  
or the Surveyor.
