the right and title of Land Certificate unto the said
Henry Cray his heirs and assigns and against
himself his heirs and assigns, and against the
Lawful Claim or Claims of any and persons
What so ever.

of twenty five dollars to me paid by Allen Franklin
of the same State and County, have bargained sold
and conveyed, and by these presents, do bargain
sell and convey into the said Allen Franklin
all my right title interest and claim ^{and} to four hundred
and forty two acres of land it being a part of the head
right certificate of land granted to Benjamin Eubank
by the Board of Land Commissioners for the County of
Tyler on the 16th day of October A.D. 1849 and numbered
13. issued to him by virtue of his Certificate no. 100.
dated 5th day of December A.D. 1839. 2nd Class, for
six hundred and forty acres of land, and the said
unconditional certificate is hereby passed into the
possession of the said Allen Franklin, it being the
same conveyed to me by Benjamin Eubank by trans-
fer bearing date the 16th day of October A.D. 1849.
I do have and to hold to him the said Allen Frank-
lin and his heirs forever, and I do hereby bind my-
self and my heirs executors and administrators or
assigns to warrant and forever defend the above
mentioned four hundred and forty two acres of land
and said certificate, being the same conveyed to me
by the said Benjamin Eubank, as above described,
to the said Allen Franklin and his heirs executors
administrators and assigns, against the claims of
every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to
claim the same or any part of said interest to me

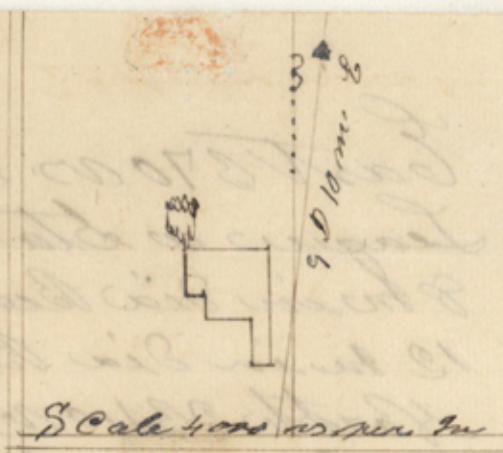
