640 ACRES.

THE STATE OF TEXAS,

Office of Commissioner of Claims.

THIS CERTIFICATE entitles the Texas and New Orleans Railroad Company, (Texas Division,) to Six Hundred and Forty Acres of Land, to be located upon any of the vacant and unappropriated Public Domain of the State of Texas, in accordance with the provisions of "An Act to encourage the construction of Railroads in Texas by donations of Lands," approved January 30th, 1854, and "An Act to amend the 3rd Section thereof," approved February 8th, 1860.

Information having been received, as required by said act, that said Company have completed an additional section of Thirty Miles (from the 50th to the 80th mile) of its Road in accordance with the provisions of its Charter and the general laws regulating Railroads. The Lands granted to said Company are to be located in alternate sections and surveyed in the following manner:

1st. For each certificate granted the Company, a like number of acres to be surveyed for the use of the State.
2d. That all surveys shall be in sections of 640 acres each, unless prevented by previous surveys or navigable streams.

3rd. That no location shall be made unless at least two surveys connected with each other can be obtained.
4th. All surveys to be delineated upon a map or maps, and deposited in the General Land Office, with the field notes thereof; and when numbered by the Commissioner of said office, the even numbers to be reserved to the State and the odd sections to become the property of the Company.

In Testimony Whereof, I hereunto set my hand and affix the impress of the Seal of said Office, at the City of Austin the 13th day of February, A. D. 1861.
