This Certificate Entitles the Buffalo Bayou, Brazos and Colorado Railroad Company to SIX HUNDRED AND FORTY Acres of Land, to be located within twelve months, upon any of the vacant and unappropriated Public Domain of the State of Texas, in accordance with the provisions of an Act to amend the Act to incorporate the Buffalo Bayou, Brazos and Colorado Railroad Company, approved January 29th. 1853.

Information having been received, as required by this Act, that said Company have completed an additional Section of five and a half miles main track, making in all eighty and a half miles from Harrisburg, and two and a half miles of turn outs, on the whole road, in accordance with the provisions of their Charter and the above recited Act.
