This Certificate entitles The **TEXAS CENTRAL RAILWAY COMPANY** to **SIX HUNDRED & FORTY ACRES** of LAND, to be located and surveyed upon any of the vacant and unappropriated public domain of the State, said company having completed and put in running order the section of **8 1/4** miles of its road, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter twelve **Title LXXXIV** of the Revised Statutes.

The lands granted to said company are to be located in alternate sections and surveyed in the following manner:

1. Two sections of land adjoining and connecting with each other must be surveyed, one for the State and the other for the Company.
2. The surveys to be made square unless prevented by previous entries or navigable streams.
3. When the field notes have been returned to the General Land Office the Commissioner will number the surveys and report the result to the Surveyor who will fill up the blanks left in his record for that purpose accordingly. (As a matter of convenience in describing the surveys when reporting the numbers, the Surveyor should number the field notes temporarily in pencil.)
4. In dividing the surveys a fraction of over three hundred and twenty acres will be counted as a whole section and two fractions of less than three hundred and twenty acres will be regarded as a section.
5. The even numbers will be reserved to the State and the odd numbers to the Company.

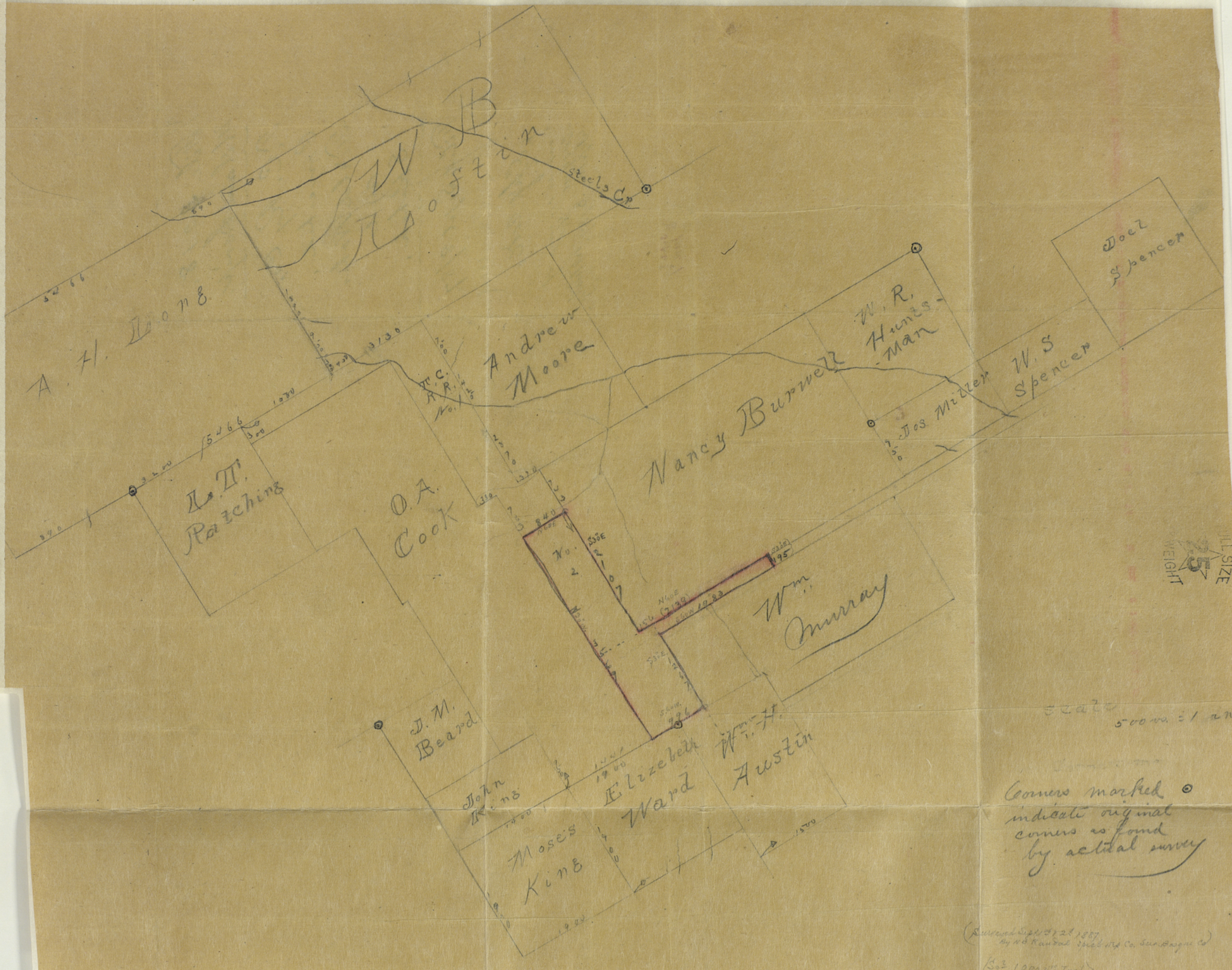

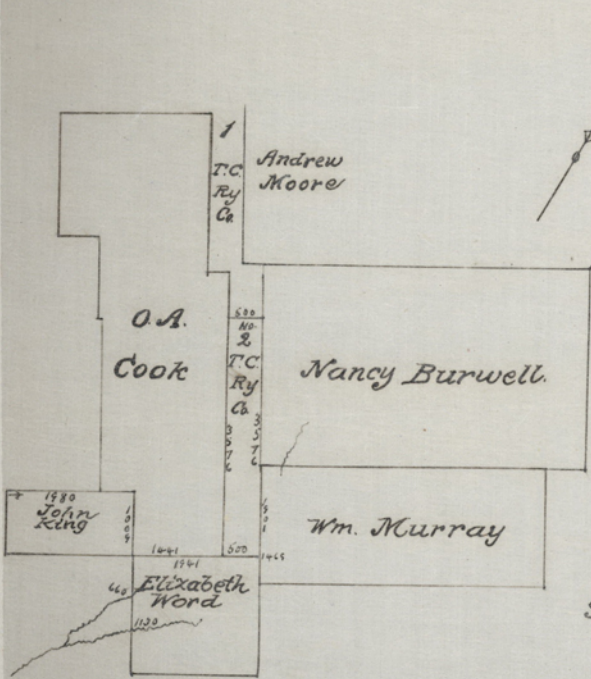

in the field notes of said King survey; Thence N60° E
1980 varas to the N.E. corner of said King survey (1900 varas
is the distance called for in field notes). He could not
find the corner as called for in the field of said King
survey; Thence S30° E 1009 varas to an old pile of rocks
for the S.E. corner of said King and N.W. corner of the
Elizabeth Ford survey; ^{He found the stumps of the pines trees at the original and corner called for in field notes} running from thence S30° E 660 varas
a branch (560 varas is the call in field notes) at 1130 varas

Dear Sir:

The District ^{Court} of Bosque County Texas, did on the 13th day of Sept. 1901 established the S. W. and N. W. corners and West line of the Wm. Murray survey, situated about 2 miles N. E. of the town of Meridian Texas and adjoining the T. C. Ry. land No. 2. I went on the ground and made a survey of said Murray survey for the benefit of said Court, prior to the trial of this case, carrying with me all the field notes of said Murray and all other surveys adjoining said survey, and located all the lines and corners of said survey according to the rules of surveying; following the foot prints of the original surveyors as near as possible. We found by beginning at the S. E. corner of said survey, and it is well established by one of the bearing trees yet standing as called for in field notes. Running from this cor. S 40° W 4014 varas the distance called for in said field notes. Could not find any evidence of the bearing trees as called for in field notes, but found said point to be out in the open prairie, where there is no appearance of any timber. By running thence N 30° W from this point we crossed a large branch on this line which is not called for in said field notes and at 1800 varas, the distance called for in field

at a point about 20 varas East of a large
branch, Could not find bearing trees.
Thence N60E at 420 varas Could not find
any evidence of a branch as called for in field
notes at this distance.

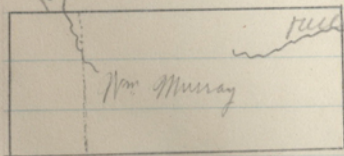
When I found no branch on the North line at
the 420 varas point, together with the crossing
of one on the West line not called for. We
then reversed the calls on said survey; that is
running N30W from the S.E. corner which
is well established to the N.E. cor. of said
survey and; thence S60W 4030 varas to a
large branch and at 4454 varas to the
N.W. corner of said Murray survey. Placing
the West line of said survey 420 var. S60W
from the crossing of the large branch
on the North line. The Court was in
possession of all this information in regard
to the location of said survey and so fixed
the judgment locating the West line of said
Murray survey
